Overview and Outcomes

This six week course will provide teachers with a solid grounding in the aspects of phonology and pronunciation. Participants will attend live sessions on Zoom once a week delivered by Mark Hancock and Stella Palavecino. These lessons will be recorded and uploaded on a virtual campus. It is important to highlight that the tutors offer participants to tailor-make the course according to their needs. Participants can either choose to improve their own pronunciation and get personalized feedback on weekly basis working with an English tutor in a person2person session, put into practice what was learn during the online sessions through assignments or/and go into phonetics pedagogy, and pronunciation lesson plans.

Whatever the choice is, the course will focus on

- both individual sounds,
- intonation,
- phonological features,
- ICT tools for pronunciation and intonation;
- language labs,
- Artificial Intelligence applied to Pronunciation

- and pedagogical matters,

All these input provides teachers with a wealth of ideas for presenting and practising pronunciation in class, identifying pronunciation problems, getting constant feedback of speaking practice, and planning lessons for a wide range of levels and age groups. Participants will have an opportunity to try out activities for both face to face and online teaching contexts.

Teaching approaches

- Pronunciation Booster V is a practical 'hands on' course, with reference to relevant theory.
- The course is participant-centred and collaborative, designed to build knowledge and confidence in pronunciation and phonology
- Tutors use activities and tasks to help participants apply the course content to their own contexts.
- Tasks are interactive, involving live online sessions,
- Opening a pronunciation community network through forums, team work through the virtual campus and community walls,
- and utilise a range of multimedia resources including images, audio files and videos.

Certification

- Participants get an end-of-course certificate signed by the tutors with a detailed list of the content covered

Tutors

Mark Hancock and Stella Palavecino are highly experienced teacher trainers, voice coaches, material writes and authors, and experts, in both pronunciation and phonology, They have been working online with teachers for continuing professional development for many years

She currently lectures in Phonetics and Phonology I and II, and English Diction at ‘Instituto Superior en Lenguas Vivas Juan R. SCHEDULE

This phonetics and pronunciation course consists of 6 modules. Each module requires approximately 5 hours work per week, including attending the webinar, revising, answering forum questions and doing weekly tasks.

Live sessions are normally held on a Saturday at 2.30 -4.00PM Argentina time, and recorded for those who are unable to attend. The questions that may come up when teachers do not join the Zoom meeting, weekly assignments or ongoing topics, are discussed in the forum during the week on the course virtual campus.
